

RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM

HOW IT WORKS



- > **Register** for the program & pay for a bin
- > **Recycle** the right items
- > Place items in the city **roll-out bin**
- > Roll bin to curb **once a month**
- > Recycling collected the **FIRST FRIDAY** of each month (Second Friday some months)

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

STEP 1

Register for the recycling program by completing the registration form online:

www.LincolntonNC.org/Recycling

STEP 2

Make sure you **ONLY** recycle items included on the list of acceptable recycling materials. Keep all items loose, do not bag recycling items!

STEP 3

Roll the filled recycling bin to the curb on the **FIRST FRIDAY** of each month for pick-up. We'll do the rest.



DO'S & DON'T'S

DO Recycle these items:

- Aluminum/steel food & drink cans – rinse and crush
- Plastic containers (rinse & flatten) with triangle recycling emblem
#1, 2 & 5 ONLY
- water/soda bottles
- milk/water jugs
- laundry/shampoo bottles
- butter/margarine tubs
- yogurt containers
- Clean cardboard - flattened
- Newspapers, glossy advertising inserts
- Phone books, magazines, computer paper
- Paper bags - flattened

TERMS

By registering to participate in the Lincolnton Residential Recycling Program you agree that:

- You are a City of Lincolnton resident
- You will only place acceptable items in the recycling bin.
- You understand contamination issues will delete you from the program. After three strikes, you will forfeit your recycling bin for one year.
- Extra bins are available per current fee schedule.

DO NOT Recycle these items:

- No glass of any kind
- No plastic #3, 4, 6 or 7
- No yard or food waste
- No plastic grocery bags (return to store)
- No styrofoam
- No used food containers, including pizza boxes – no soiled paper/food debris
- No incandescent light bulbs or fluorescent tubes
- No hazardous waste or paint
- No electronics
- No plastic bottles that contained automotive or petroleum products
- No propane/gas cylinders of any type
- No hardback books
- No batteries
- No clothing or toys
